Dear Mr. Smith:

For many years, our facility, Pier Pointe Marina, located on Great Sodus Bay in Lake Ontario, New York, has suffered from exposure to Southeastern storms and heavy wind effects. These conditions resulted in continuing wave and wake disruptions of boats and structures at the marina. It seemed imperative that we mitigate the effects of these conditions, or risk the loss of our customer base. We were well aware the previous owners who operated under the name Anchor Marina were not able to keep their slips full and were unable to expand their business.

When our company purchased the property, we were determined to provide protection for our 800-foot main dock and side floating slips. We knew that to expand our business, present and future customers would need to be satisfied with the integrity of their slips. We needed to provide that security to fill the existing slips and create demand for the additional dockage envisioned in our business plan. We knew that if we were able to fulfill these objectives, we would greatly increase the value of our property and enhance the security of our investment.

We investigated numerous possible solutions to our wave and wake problems. We reviewed wave attenuators including floating docks, metal structures, tire reefs and rubble breakwaters. All of these potential solutions had significant drawbacks, either because of permitting concerns, lack of effectiveness or damage to the environment.

In deciding on the WhisprWave design, we felt we had found a viable solution to our problem. We were somewhat apprehensive because we knew there had been no previous installations and therefore Pier Pointe would be the first facility protected by the WhisprWave.

Because we were the first installation, new procedures and techniques had to be mastered in the assembly process. During the period of assembly your crew was able to reduce the build-time of a fifty-foot section, of the breakwater, from three days to four hours. Your determination to make the installation successful quickly helped us overcome any anxiety about being the first WhisprWave customer.

It is now three years since the WhisprWave was first installed. We have successfully completed the seasonal cycles sinking and refloating the breakwater each autumn and spring respectively. Our clients and we have enjoyed the protection afforded by the WhisprWave, which has exceeded all of our expectations. Our clients can now peacefully sleep on their boats without wave disturbance and without the threat of damage to their vessels. We have been able to rent additional slips and have extended our floating docks. Environmentally, the WhisprWave has been friendly to nature providing shelter to fish, gulls and ducks. Not a single gull lives on our docks or in the rigging of our clients' vessels but rather the sea birds prefer to live on the WhisprWave with resulting environmental benefits to both our facility, the gulls and our docks.

What has been particularly interesting is that in the three years of use, there has been little or no maintenance to the breakwater. Except for the yearly lowering and raising of the structure to protect it from ice damage and an annual high pressure washing to clean its surface, there have been no maintenance hours expended on the WhisprWave.


